








Libraries 101 for potential partners - Country profiles










































Percentage of engaged countries/territories




Data Availability Percentage Index (DAPI)




DAPI - Regions, 2019




DAPI – Library Types World, 2019

Metrics on user training and events

NAPLE meeting, 10 June 2021



metrics we consider for LMW in future

- 1. Number of training events, including formal and non-formal
- 2. Number of trained individuals
- 3. Number of informal training incidences such as assistance, consultations, point-of-use training
- 4. Number of assisted/consulted individuals
- Number of **other events**, i.e., events that are not explicitly designed as training events but have cultural, educational, social, political, scholarly, or other intent.
